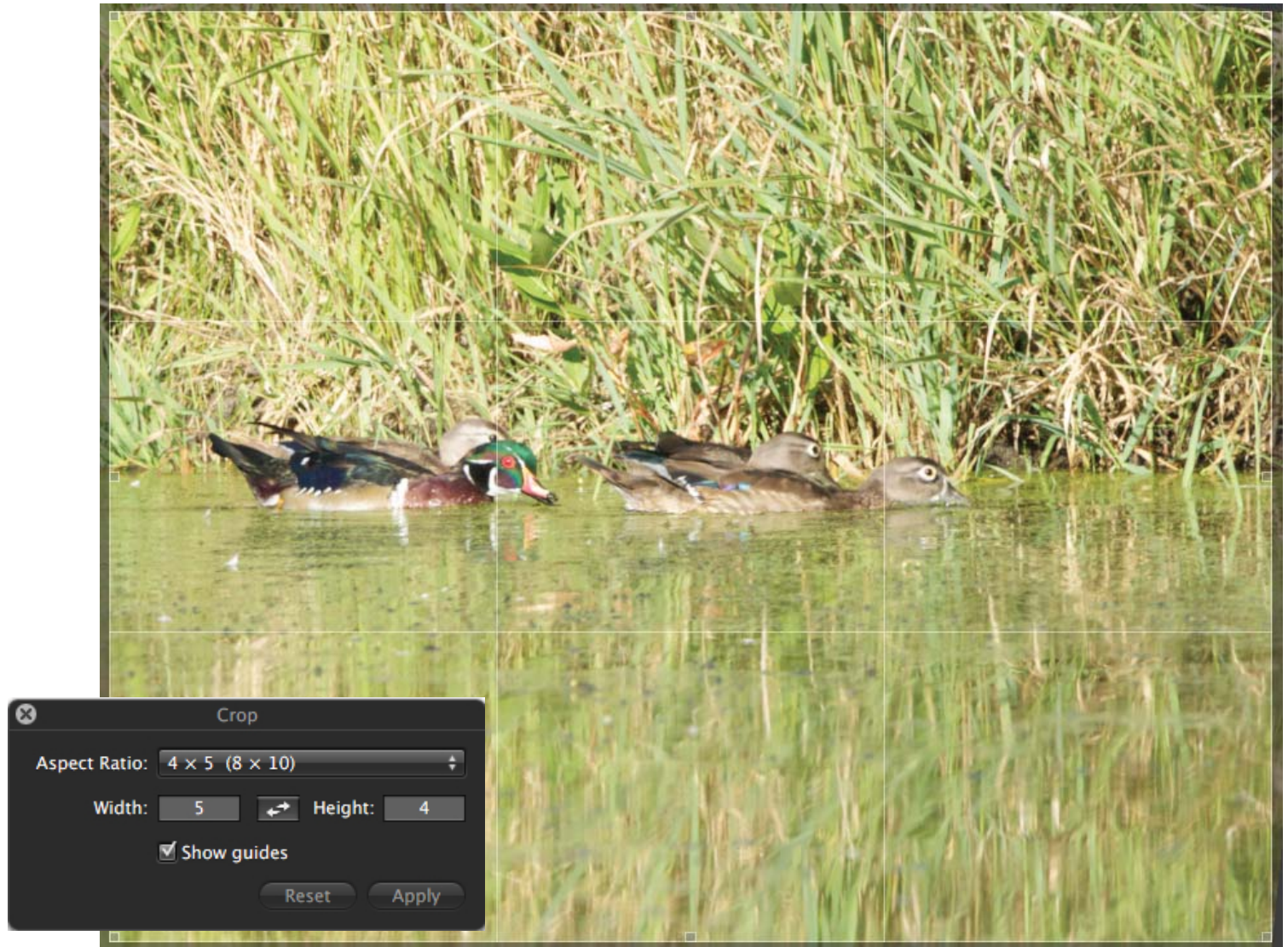
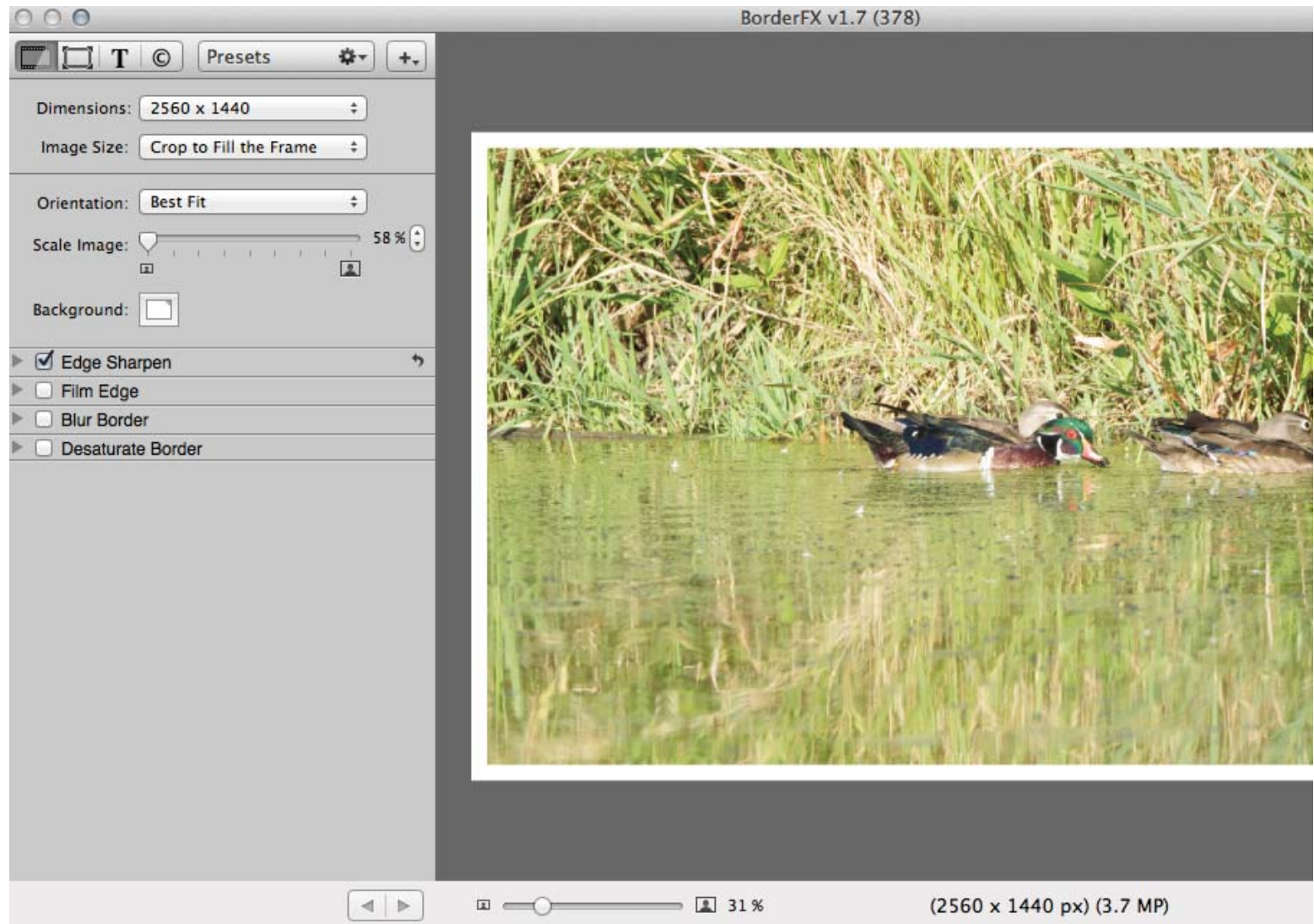


1: In Aperture, once your final edits are complete, crop your image down to the desired ratio



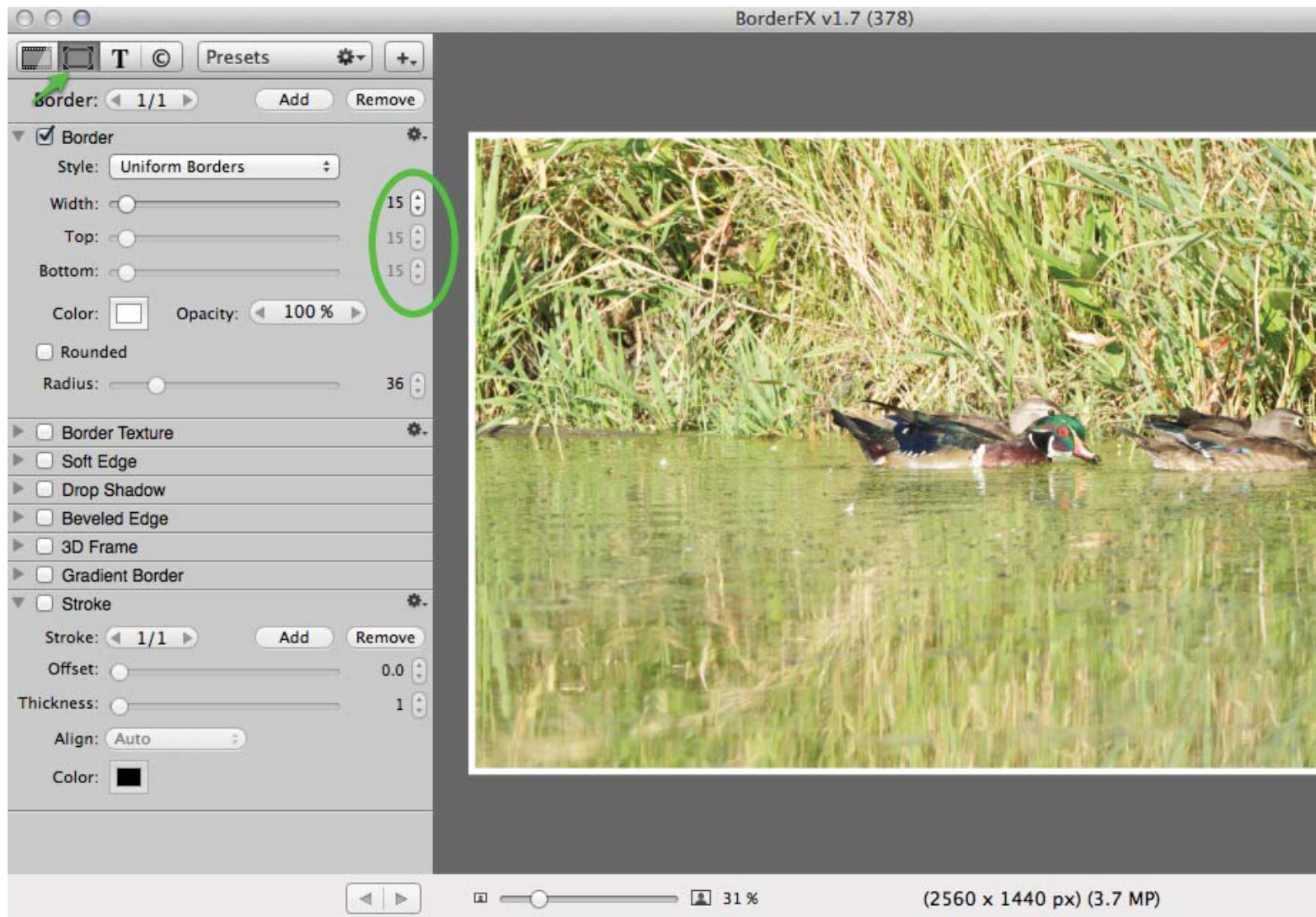
2: Open your image in the BoarderFX plug-in

- Set your “Dimensions” to the crop ratio your image was set to in Aperture



3: Switch to your “borders” section (green arrow)

- For the purpose of a competition border, the only setting I recommend changing is the pixel size (green circle) – and I’d start off with 15.
- You can also save this as a preset so that you don’t have to reset it every time



3: In the bottom right of the border window, select “Save”

- Select “Save by: Importing new Image”
 - This will save it back in Aperture as a new version of your original image
- For competition purposes, I’d recommend the JPEG setting and select the max quality setting of 12.

You should be all set! Move on to printing that version (or export it to send to your print house of choice) and you should be all set!
